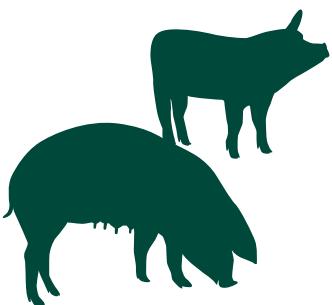

FREE ACCESS FARROWING PEN

The Porcon free access farrowing pen enriches the living conditions of the sow without compromising the safety of the piglets. A few days after farrowing, this pen provides the sow with more freedom to exercise and to stay in good condition. This movement stimulates milk production helping the piglets to grow better.



Greater comfort for sows and piglets

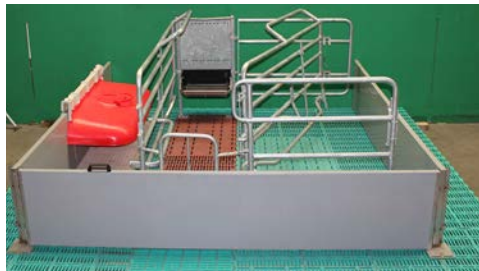
- › Free-standing farrowing pen with a handy, pre-perforated steel plate for easy installation of feeding and drinking systems.
- › The piglets can move around the sow; the trough does not form an obstacle.
- › Anti-crush bars protect the piglets.
- › Piglet nest is close to the sow's udder.
- › Cast iron slats underneath the sow, if required, include a solid shoulder plate.
- › PVC partitions are 20 inches (500 mm) tall for easy pen access.
- › Easy to move side gates ensure the system's reliability and reduce the work load.
- › Spacious walking surface offers safety and more comfort to the piglets.



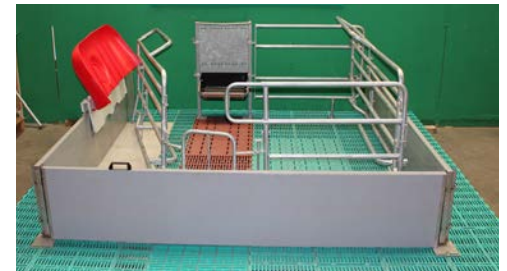
One side gate is moved to the side of the pen to create the free access position. This is a smooth and easy movement that increases the working life of the pen.



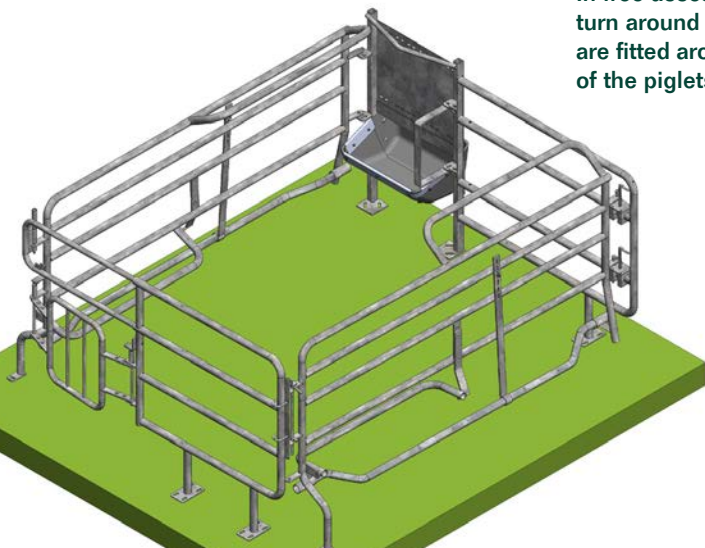
When the side gate is open, the sow can leave the farrowing pen easily.



In free access position, the sow can easily turn around and lie down. Anti-crush bars are fitted around the pen to ensure the safety of the piglets.



The sow can also exit the pen from the front: this enables a pen arrangement parallel to the feeding corridor.
